We are pleased to announce the 2008 winners of the Liberty Mutual Medal for the best research in the area of OHS submitted to the IEA judging panel. The paper selected was "Digging Deeper: An investigation into OHS in the New South Wales mining industry" by Shaw, A. et al. from Australia. A co-author, Verna Blewett was present at the Council meeting as one of the Australian delegates when Pierre Falzon made the announcement. This was a wonderful surprise. Under the new arrangements between the IEA and Ian Noy from Liberty Mutual an annual prize of US\$10,000 is provided by Liberty Mutual to the winning authors. This is the most valuable and prestigious prize for research in the ergonomics domain.
