2. IEA / Liberty Mutual Medal Winner for 2009

I am pleased to announce that the 2009 winner of the \$10,000 Liberty Mutual Medal for Occupational Safety and Ergonomics is Dr Suman Singh from the College of Home Sciences, Maharana Pratap University of Agriculture & Technology, Udaipur, Rajasthan, India. Her paper was titled: "Mitigating occupational health hazards of women farmers through educational and technological interventions". The committee was impressed (a) by the systems approach of combining ergonomic design/redesign of equipment and development and application of a training program involving participatory field level skill training and repeated field demonstrations in the proper use of the ergonomically improved farm instruments, and (b) the impact of the project, which directly benefitted 4,200 women, and potentially can benefit many more farm workers in IDC's.
