Times roman type (or similar)
Title 16 point, with initial capital for first word
Authors' name 12 point, initial capitals, centered
Affiliations 12 point, initial capitals, centered
Headings 12 point, initial capitals, for first

word bold type

Citations to references: Use the numerical system [1]. References should be numbered sequentially throughout the text [2, 3].
